<b>When</b>	Saturday 2 March 2019
<b>Where</b>	Appleby College, 540 Lakeshore Rd West, Oakville ON L6K 3P1
<b>Teams</b>	Each school may send two teams of two debaters (3 if space permits). Students must be in Grades 7, 8 or 9
<b>Judges</b>	Coaches will be expected to judge at this tournament. Experienced senior debaters (grade 12) are welcome as additional judges.
<b>Prepared Resolution</b>	<b>This house would cease exploitation of resources in the Arctic Region.</b>
<b>Style</b>	All five rounds will be in the Canadian National Debate Style. Two rounds will be on the prepared topic and three rounds will be impromptu topics.
<b>Speaking Times</b>	6 minute constructive; 3 minutes for 1 <sup>st</sup> Opp and 1 <sup>st</sup> Prop summary speeches
<b>Registration</b>	Please register your teams by <b>Friday 8 February 2019</b> . Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. After the 8 <sup>th</sup> , schools who have requested a third team will be contacted. <b><i>Please note that if you request a third team, you must also provide a second judge.</i></b>
<b>Fees</b>	\$90 per two-person team. Cheques should be payable to <b>Ontario Student Debate Union</b> . Continental breakfast, lunch and snacks are provided.
