

Queen's Highschool Debate Championship 2021

Tournament Dates: January 9th-10th (Online) **Registration Fee:** \$30 per team

Tournament information

This year's tournament will be taking place over Discord. A guide for how to set up and use discord will be provided to registrants via email. The tournament will consist of six preliminary rounds of British Parliamentary (BP) style debate. A written guide to BP debate will be provided to registrants via email.

The top 16 teams will break to quarter finals on Sunday. Winners will then proceed to semifinals, followed by the grand final. There will also be a junior final for teams in grade 9 and below which will take place concurrently with the semi final.

The first four rounds of debate will all have open adjudication, meaning that debaters will be told the outcome of the round and given constructive feedback from their judge(s). Debaters may seek individual feedback after the RFD has been given via message or voice on discord. All motions will be straight motions. Squirreling of changing the motion are strictly prohibited.

Seminar

There will be a seminar during the Saturday lunch break for participants of the tournament.

Awards

Digital awards will be given to the top ten overall speakers, as well as the top three junior speakers. Awards will also be given to all quarterfinalists, semifinalists, and finalists.
