McMaster High Schools will consist of five (5) preliminary rounds breaking to quarterfinals, all in British Parliamentary (BP) style. We are proud to announce that the adjudication core for this tournament consists of Angad Singh and Meehakk Mulani as Chief Adjudicators.

Registration for the tournament will open on Thursday, March 25 at 12:01 PM EST. Registration fees will be \$40 per team. We are excited to announce that the McMaster High Schools 2021 will be the first tournament in the world to award the tournaments champions with a one of kind, non-fungible token. A unique piece of art, backed by the blockchain, the NFT will serve as the tournament trophy and allow the champions to possess a piece of debate history.

REGISTRATION

Registration for this tournament opens at **12:01 PM** on **Thursday, March 25**. Institutions may reserve team spots using this form: <u>https://forms.gle/HkFAFMy2TDHnCHDF7</u>. Spots will be given on a first-come, firstserve basis. As such, we urge institutions to reserve spots as soon as possible to hold their place in the tournament. In the interest of fairness, form submissions that are completed prior to the registration window opening will be disregarded.

There will be a soft team cap of eight (8) teams per institution. Additional teams may be requested by institutions at the time of registration and will be confirmed after the final registration deadline. There will be a total team cap of 148 teams for this tournament – the organizational committee reserves the right to change the team cap under extenuating circumstances.

After reserving spots, institutions will be emailed with further details regarding submitting payment and participant information. Please note that full payment and debater details must be submitted by **Friday**, **April 23**. Exceptions may be made however this must be discussed with the tournament directors beforehand.
