

Ontario British Parliamentary Qualifier

Dear Ontario Coaches.

The Ontario Student Debating Union (OSDU) is pleased to invite you to the 2023 Ontario British Parliamentary Qualifier to be run **October 28**, **2023 (note – a one-day tournament)**.

This tournament will act as the qualifying tournament for the Canadian British Parliamentary Debate Championships in Winnipeg, taking place from November 17-19, 2023. Please understand that should you qualify for this tournament, you will be expected to confirm and register in very short notice and book transportation to Saskatchewan within this time period.

Location:

This tournament will be held on Saturday October 28, 2023 at:

Toronto French School 318 Lawrence Ave E, Toronto ON M4N 1T7.

Please use the main entrance off Lawrence Ave. when entering the school.

Please note, there will not be sufficient parking on site during this tournament. Please use either public transportation (Lawrence Subway Station, then bus #124 or the #11), or locate alternate parking arrangements. Please contact us for more information. There is a car park at the northern end of the school (entrance off Bayview southbound) if arriving from the north.

Divisions:

U-15 Division:

All students must be 15 years of age or less as of September 1st, 2020. This means that the U- 15 category is open only to students born **after September 1st, 2008.** To compete in this age category, both debaters must qualify.

Senior Division:

All high school students are eligible to compete in the Senior Division, provided they are still high-school students during the current academic year.

Please note that hybrid teams are not eligible to compete in this event, meaning that both debaters must be from the same school. In addition, all schools participating **must** be members of OSDU.

Registration:

The registration deadline for this tournament will be **Monday the 16**th of October, at midnight. Please ensure that you have completed all items below by that time.

Each school is eligible to send up to four teams in total. No more than three teams can be in the same division (i.e. 3-1 or 2-2 is acceptable, but all four teams can not be in the same division). Should you have an interest in sending additional teams in either division, please let us know and we will allow extra teams if possible closer to the tournament date.

In addition, there will be an online workshop for participants led by OSDU Board Member and Debate Coach at TFS on **12 October from 6:30-8:30 pm**. This is aimed for those who would like to know more about British Parliamentary format and answer questions. If you are interested, please fill out this form **no later than 10 October**.

Please also note that if you drop out of the tournament after Friday October 20, 2023 (one week before the tournament), you will still be held financially liable for all registration fees. All debaters are expected to have an adult chaperone present and registered for the entirety of the event. Unchaperoned debaters will not be permitted. Chaperones do not pay the registration fee. **Chaperones must also judge.**

Debate Format:

This tournament will be conducted **in British Parliamentary Format**. It will be composed of four impromptu rounds of debate, breaking to an open grand final. **There will be no prepared resolution for this tournament.** We will be using **5 minute** speaking times for each speech in both age categories to remain consistent with the National level BP Championships Tournament. All debates will take place in English only.
